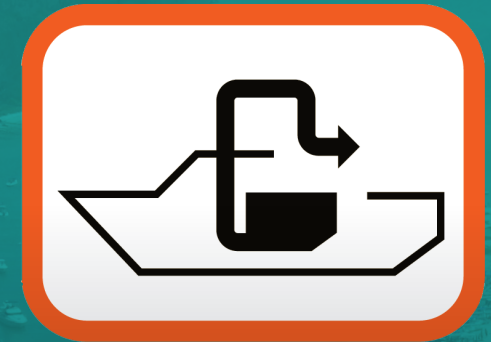

*Use Pumpouts*



## PUMPOUT GRANTS

The Clean Vessel Act Program can fund up to 75% of eligible project costs relating to installation, operations and maintenance of:

- Stationary pumpouts.
- Mobile pumpout carts.
- In-slip pumpout system.
- Pumpout vessels.
- Sewage dump stations.
- Connection to sewage lateral.
- Sewage hauling.

### Pumpout Nav App

This free app allows boaters to find the closest sewage pumpout or dump station, report broken stations and save their favorite locations. The app makes pumpouts more accessible to boaters, prevents overboard sewer discharges, and protects waterways.

### Pumpout Needs Assessment

Florida has the highest level of recreational boaters in the nation! Are we, as a community, meeting their needs for proper sewage disposal? A state-wide assessment will help determine where additional resources are needed the most.
